## **Apa Table Of Contents**

APA style does not require a table of contents, but there are cases where you may need to include one. For example, your instructor may specify that your paper must be submitted with a table of contents. A table of contents can be particularly helpful in cases where your paper is lengthy or covers a lot of material, such as a thesis paper or dissertation.

## **APA Format Table of Contents - Verywell Mind**

The most important thing to know about creating an automatic Table of Contents in Word is that you first need to format your document using the Heading Styles. That's because it's the Heading Styles formatting (as you can see pictured below) that feeds your Table of Contents. This step is explained in detail below.

## **How to Make a Table of Contents in Word (Step-by-Step)**

The Table of Contents (TOC) is an organized listing of the chapters and major sections of your document. Readers will immediately be able to see how your manuscript is organized and then skip down to sections that are most relevant to them. A clear, concise, and well formatted TOC is the first indicator of a good research paper.

## **APA Paper Format: Guidelines, Sections, Tips**

On the APA reference page, you list all the sources that you've cited in your paper. The list starts on a new page right after the body text. Follow these instructions to set up your APA reference page: Place the section label "References" in bold at the top of the page (centered). Order the references alphabetically. Double-space all text.

## **Setting up the APA Reference Page | Formatting & References**

The Table of Contents in a document acts as a map for the reader, making it easier for them to find information in the document based on title and page number. A good Table of Contents should be organized, easy to read and simple to use. You can write a Table of Contents manually on your computer or have a word processing tool create it for you.
