Chicago style paper no title page is often the case when you are writing a smaller piece – for example, a 5-paragraph essay, and a separate title page is simply unjustified. However, most often, your Chicago style research paper will compose of three main parts: the cover page (title), the main body, and the works cited page.

The title of the paper should be 1/3 of the way down If there is a title and subtitle, the two should be on different lines, separated by a colon. About 2/3 of the way down the page should contain your name, the date, and any other information required by your instructor.

The Chicago Style of writing is often used for history papers, but this style is called Turabian Style when referring specifically to research papers. The Chicago Manual of Style was first written in 1891 by the University of Chicago Press in order to standardize the process of revising and editing the many papers proofreaders were being given.

### **Turabian Format and Style Guide With Examples**

Improper formatting techniques affect the overall grade of your research paper or essay. Professors sometimes instruct students to follow a specific format. It can be either an MLA or Chicago style. However, students find it challenging to meet these formatting techniques thoroughly.

### **Chicago Paper Format - Essay Masters**

Chicago style is a standard used for formatting scholarly books. Turabian knew that most students are concerned with writing papers, so she narrowed the focus and refined the rules specifically for paper writing. Turabian style omits some of the information that is relevant for publishing, but it also departs from Chicago Style in a few other ways.

### **Chicago Style Format for Papers | Requirements & Examples**

Technically, a Chicago style research paper or essay can use any font type or size to use in one’s paper. The only requirement is that the font is clearly readable. So, the choice is up to you. We suggest that you don’t get inventive here and stick to Times New Roman size 12.

### **SAMPLE CHICAGO PAPER - Concordia University, St. Paul**

Double-space the text of the paper. Use left-justified text, which will have a ragged right edge. Do not use fully (newspaper-style) justified text. Use a 1/2" indent for paragraph beginnings, block quotes and hanging (bibliography) indents. Number the pages in the top right corner of the paper, beginning with the first page of text.

### **Essay Formatting: APA, Chicago, MLA**

Chicago Manual of Style offers the option to use footnotes, endnotes or parenthetical in-text citations featuring an author / date format. Footnotes or endnotes allow for citation information to be easily accessible at the bottom of each page (footnotes) or at the end of the paper (endnotes).

Paper. For a Chicago essay, you use standard white A4 paper size 8.5 x 11-inches. Don't use any coloured paper or ones with fancy designs. Stick with the basic white paper at all times. Font. Whenever drafting a Chicago essay, you need to go with a font that is easy to read and understand. Go with something like Times New Roman, Arial or Courier.
